## OPENING HOURS of Museums, Collections, Libraries

**Art and History Museum, Rue Charles Galland.** — The Museum is opened in winter on Thursday and Sunday from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 4 1/2 P. M.; on other days from 2 to 4 1/2 P. M.; in summer, from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M.

Entrance free on Thursday, Saturday afternoon and Sunday. On other days entrance fee 1 fr. (50 centimes per person for groups of 5 people and more). The Museum is closed on Monday morning.

**Natural History Museum, Promenade des Bastions.** — Entrance free. From November 1st, to February 28th., on Sunday from 10 to 12 A. M., and from 1 1/2 to 4 P. M., on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, from 1 1/2 to 4 1/2 P. M. From March 1st, to October 31st., on Sunday from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M.; on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, from 2 to 5 P. M. For visiting the Museum between the opening hours, apply to the concierge.

The local collection, in the Palais Eynard, is opened on Thursday and Sunday from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M.

**Ethnographical Museum, Parc Mon Repos.** — From October 15th. to April 14th. from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 4 1/2 P. M. From April 15th. to October 14th. from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M. Entrance free on Thursday and Sunday, on other days entrance fee 50 centimes per person. The Museum is closed on Saturday afternoon.

**Rath Museum, Place Neuve.** — (Temporary exhibitions). Same hours as the Art and History Museum. Entrance free on Thursday and Sunday.

**Watchmaking Museum, Rue Necker.** — Opened on Thursday from 1 to 4 P. M. and on Sunday from 9 to 12 A. M.

**Ariana Museum, Parc de l'Ariana.** — The Museum is opened every day, except on Saturday, from April 1st. to May 31st., from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M. from June 1st. to September 15th. until 6 P. M.; and from September 16th. to November 1st. from 10 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M. Entrance free during these periods on Sunday; on other days the collection may be visited, as well as during the winter months, for an entrance fee of 50 centimes.

**Botanical Conservatory and Botanical Garden, La Consoie, Lausanne road.** — Every day from 2 to 5 P. M., except on Sunday. The Garden is opened every day, in summer from 8 to 12 A. M., from 2 to 5 P. M., in winter from 8 A. M. until night.

**Public and University Library, Promenade des Bastions.** — Opening hours: Reading Room: 9 to 12 A. M., and 2 to 7 P. M. (Saturday until 5 P. M.); from November 1st. to April 30th., it is also opened from 8 to 10 P. M. Consultation Room for manuscripts, prints and J.-J. Rousseau Archives: 9 to 12 A. M. from 2 to 6 P. M. (except on Saturday afternoon). Salle Gustave Moynier (Periodicals Room): 9 to 12 A. M.; 2 to 7 P. M. (Saturday until 5 P. M.). Salle Ami Lullin (exhibition of manuscripts and portraits) and J.-J. Rousseau Museum: opened free on Sunday and Thursday from 1 to 4 P. M. Entrance fee between opening hours: 50 centimes per person, 25 centimes per person for groups of 5 people and more.

**Maps Depository and Cartographical Museum, Promenade des Bastions.** — The Depository is opened on Monday, Tuesday, Friday from 4 1/2 to 6 P. M. The Museum is opened free on Sunday from 2 to 5 P. M.

**Athenaeum.** — Permanent Paintings Exhibition. Opened every day: 10 to 12 A. M.; 1 1/2 to 6 P. M. Sunday from 10 to 12 A. M. Entrance fee: 60 centimes.

**Art and Craft School, (Section des Arts Industriels), Boulevard James Fazy.** — Museum of castings, representation of persons and decoration, comparative sculpture. Permanent exhibition opened free every day except Saturday and Sunday from 9 to 12 A. M. and from 2 to 5 P. M.

**St. Peter's Cathedral and Maccabees Chapel.** May be visited every day, in summer from 8 to 12 A. M., from 1 to 7 P. M.; in winter from 9 to 12 A. M., from 1 P. M. until night. Entrance fee: 25 centimes per person. Visit of the towers, from one to four persons: 1 fr.; for groups of more than 4 persons: 25 centimes per person. The Cathedral is closed on Sunday at 4 P. M., in winter, at 5 P. M., in summer.

**Theater, Place Neuve.** — May be visited outside of the theatrical season from 10 to 4 P. M.

**Victoria Hall (Concert Hall), Rue Général Dufour, 14.** — For visiting apply to the concierge.

**Russian Church.** — Opened every day. Apply to the concierge.

**Water Works Building, La Coulouvrenière.** — Opened free every day.
