



was Conquered from the Poles, by the Teutonic Knights about 1230, and remained Subject to them till 1525, when their Grand Master, ALBERT, Margrave of BRANDENBURG, was created Duke; & PRUSSIA continued an Hereditary Duchy till 1701, when Duke FREDERICK was formally acknowledged the first King of PRUSSIA.

Royal Prussia, now called EAST PRUSSIA, was never dependent on the Crown of Poland. Polish Prussia, now named WEST PRUSSIA, was a part of the Kingdom of Poland till it was dismembered in 1773. Great Poland, now SOUTH PRUSSIA, was united to the Kingdom of Prussia by Treaty of 1793, as was NEW EAST PRUSSIA, at the final Dissolution of the Kingdom of Poland in 1795.
